Stage 3 - Years 5 and 6

Literacy	Numeracy

Writing Focus:

 Students will explore Google Sites this week and begin converting their informative texts into a website.

Spelling and Grammar:

 Using knowledge of known words and base words to spell new words. For group D the focus is using their knowledge of spelling rules to correct misspelt words in sentences. Group D will focus on the morphograph i-e-v-e.

Reading Focus:

 Literacy circle groups have now rotated their topics. Students will be working on chunk 5 of their assigned texts for literacy circles. Reader's theatre will also be rehearsed and performed in class.

Numeracy Focus:

- Fractions and Decimals: Adding and subtracting fractions with unlike denominators.
- Chance: determining the likely make-up of a large collection of objects, by sampling objects and returning them to the collection before the next sample.
- Students will also complete an assessment for fractions, decimals and percentages, chance, three-dimensional space and volume and capacity.

No other canteen items will be available for purchase on this day.


